

How to Download Kindle-Compatible E-Books from OverDrive

In order to download Kindle-compatible e-books, you will need to have an Amazon account. If you own a Kindle, have downloaded the Kindle app, or have made previous purchases on Amazon, you may already have an account, and can use that information to sign-in. For more information, see our handout titled *How to Create an Amazon Account*.

1. Visit the library website at www.ecpubliclibrary.info
2. Select **Downloadable Media** from the Services tab on the home page.
3. Click on **OverDrive** to go to the OverDrive information page. This page has general information about OverDrive as well as several video tutorials which will walk you through the download process click-by-click.
4. Click on **OverDrive** to go to the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium (WPLC) page.
5. Sign in to see the most accurate availability. To do so, tap Sign In, in the upper right corner.
6. Tap on the **[select library]** icon. Select the **Indianhead Federated Library System**.
7. You will now see a space to enter your library card number. Enter the number and then tap Sign In.
8. You may now begin to browse or search. To browse, you may tap on any of the collections in the dark blue section. If you would like to search for something specific, tap **Advanced Search**, located just under the search box.
9. You may now perform a search with multiple limiters. If you are just looking for anything available, we suggest limiting the format to **Kindle Book** and selecting **Available Now** (located near the bottom of the list) and then tap **Search**.
10. From the list, find a book you would like to check out, and tap the book image.
11. Next, tap **Borrow**.
12. You will now see two brown icons next to the book cover image. One that says **Download**, and one that says **Read**. Click on the **Download** icon.
13. Select the **Kindle Book** format, and then click on **Confirm and Download**.
14. You will then be redirected to the Amazon website and a screen with a summary of the e-book you checked out will show up.
15. At this time, Amazon may ask you for your Amazon account information. Enter your log-in information, if needed.
16. Once you're ready to sync or download to your Kindle, click the **Get Library Book** button.
17. After you have signed in, you will see the **Deliver To** section. Select the Kindle device or app to which you wish to send your e-book.
18. Then, click the **Continue** button.
19. If your Kindle is connected to Wi-Fi your e-book will show up on your Kindle home screen. If your e-book does not load wirelessly, you may follow the directions Amazon provides for transferring titles with a USB cord connection.
