Artist Statement (optional):

An artist statement is a piece of writing by you (the artist) that helps the audience access or understand your work. It usually contains a “how”, “what,” and “why.” You don’t need to answer all the questions below; they are simply meant to help guide you in writing your artist statement. The guiding question can be, “what can I share about my work to help the audience understand?”

How: How did you create your work? Describe your work: what colors did you use, what tools did you use, what techniques did you use?

What: Is your art abstract, realistic, 3-dimensional, etc.? What medium did you use: photography, drawing, sculpture, etc.? How do you describe your style?

Why: Why do you make what you make? What motivates you to create? What message do you mean to communicate? Explain the influences behind and the meanings of your work.
