

A joint meeting of the special committee appointed by the city council and all of the library board was held at the office of the Davis & Starr Lumber Co., at three o'clock P. M., on April 22nd, 1902.

The meeting was addressed by Jos. W. Singleton in favor of the site offered by Peter Truax on Grand Avenue West. In the course of his remarks Mr. Singleton stated that the sum of ¹1500⁰⁰ dollars subscribed by residents of the west side would be tendered to reduce the cost of the site to the city.

A committee was appointed, consisting of Messrs Cyprean-
sen, Lockwood and Frawley to secure a price on the Reed
site at the corner of Farwell street and Grand Avenue East.
A general discussion followed in regard to the various
sites tendered, but no formal action was taken.

On motion, the meeting adjourned.
