Special Meeting at Library Room August 31 1901

Room Committee reported on Childrens Room. They had found the space in the Farwell House to consist of a front room 14-28 and a rear room 12-14. The owner would put in an arch between and would rent for \$8 per month. Water and gas would have to be put in and much repairing was badly needed. This location was not recommended by the committee. The room in Burgar Block was found to be 18-40, in fair repair, and with water and gas. It was the only suitable room to be had near the Library and could be leased for \$15 a month. No formal action was taken on the report.

The Librarian reported that fumigation of all books returned was necessary two or three times a week. It was ordered continued until further notice at the expense of the Board of Health.
