 resolution was offered:

 tion has been reluctantly accepted by the Board,

 as a body our sincere regret that Miss  
 Sutermeister should think best to leave her  
 work in this Library and community and  
 that we assure her our appreciation and

and entire satisfaction with the able way and manner in which she has organized the work in the library and so greatly increased its efficiency that we convey to her our most sincere good wishes for her future happiness and prosperity wherever she may be."

The resolution was adopted by unanimous vote and was ordered spread upon the records of this Board and a copy of the same furnished to Miss Determister.

~~The~~ Miss Ellen D. Peisner who had been selected at a former meeting to succeed Miss Determister being present in the City was formally appointed as Librarian, to enter upon her duties at once.
