but if I live perhaps another year I may com
My health has been very bad this winter & tho'
I am better still my cough is very bad & I have
a good deal of pain in & through my lungs
and in my side Grand Pa has been a week
down, has had a cough something uncommon
for him but he is well now it has been very
sickly here this winter twice than has been
some funerals in one day & one family lost
six children 3 of them buried at one time
yesterday there was four funerals all
Catholics & today another has died on
Palmer hill a man who died with consump-
ption & Mr Rogers ^{is} almost gone cannot live
long his disease of the kidneys & pronounced
inevitable I am going write a letter or find
one I began when Latty was sick from last
to Daisy & send a ring in it for her from
him & he is going to send one to Mabel & I
shall have write to her for him & I have a

it give my love to all & tell Mama I think she
is too bad that she dont write Tell Papa I will ans.
