The monthly Library Board meeting for February, regularly held on the fourth Tuesday of the month, was postponed to Tuesday February 7, 1922. Present: President Coffin, Directors Frawley, Singleton, Ager, Owen, Lockerby, Merrill, Linderman, and Bartlett. The minutes of the two previous meetings were read and approved.

Mr. Merrill for the executive committee brought up the matter of insurance on the library books at the High School, and same was referred to the executive committee with power to act.
