

EAU CLAIRE PUBLIC LIBRARY
RECORD BOOK

The regular monthly meeting of the Library Board was held Monday evening, May 28, 1917. Present President Coffin, Directors Ager, Frawley, Merrill, Lockerby and Bartlett.

The minutes of the two previous meetings were read and approved.

The Executive Committee reported that their committee, on the recommendation of our librarian and after consultation with other members of the Library board had engaged Miss Ruth Soranson to take the place as Children's Librarian in place of Miss Fisher who had resigned. The salary of Miss Soranson to be \$55.00 per month and her service to begin August first.

On motion it was voted to extend to Mr. S.S. Kepler the thanks of the Board for the two flowering shrubs presented by him to the library and which shrubs were duly planted on the eighth of May on the library lawn, the one on the south side of building being named for Miss Sutermeister now Mrs Delap of Kansas City, the first trained librarian of the Eau Claire Public library and the other on the north side for Miss Laura Olsen, the present Librarian. A communication was received from Mrs Delap expressing her appreciation of the above recognition of her service in our library.

The Librarian's report was read and on motion placed on file.

On motion it was voted that the Librarian be instructed to deposit \$200.00 of the desk funds with the City Treasurer.
