DIY Scrub Cleaner



What you'll need . . .

- » Airtight storage container
- » 1 cup baking soda
- » ¼ cup liquid castile soap
- » 3-5 drops tea tree oil*
- » Fragrance oil (if desired)
- » Water

* Tea tree oil is antibacterial, antimicrobial, and antiviral. Use topically only in a diluted form, as in this scrub.

Combine baking soda, liquid soap, and tea tree oil in bowl. Add 1-2 drops fragrance oil if desired. Add enough water to form a loose paste and mix well.

To use, apply with a sponge or cloth, scrub, and rinse thoroughly. If the scrub loses moisture over time, simply add water and mix or shake.

You can store the scrub in a plastic storage bag temporarily. For long-term storage, try a wide mouth glass jar or old shampoo bottle.
