Gentlemen:-

We do hereby respectfully report to your Honorable Body, that the Board of Directors of the Eau Claire Public Library, of the City of Eau Claire, has selected as a library site for the City of Eau Claire, the following described real estate in the City of Eau Claire, in Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, described as follows, to-wit:-

Lots six (6) seven (7) and eight (8) Block twenty (20) Village of Eau Claire now City of Eau Claire in said City of Eau Claire aforesaid, and we have contracted for the purchase of said site for the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars, which is the amount required to pay for said site, and we recommend that your honorable body provide by resolution, for the payment of said purchase price, in the manner provided by law, upon tender to the City of Eau Claire of a good and sufficient deed to said City of said property, and on the furnishing to said City of an abstract of title, showing that the title of said premises, so conveyed to said City, is a good and sufficient title and free and clear from all liens and incumbrances.
