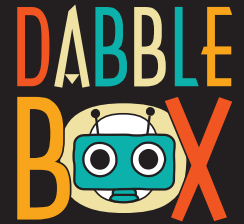


MAKER IN RESIDENCE*

Jenna Vande Zande | June 5 to June 30, 2023

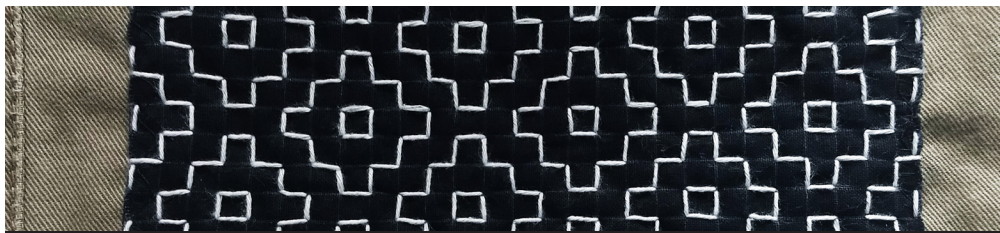


Drop in and learn about textile repair during Jenna's in-studio hours.

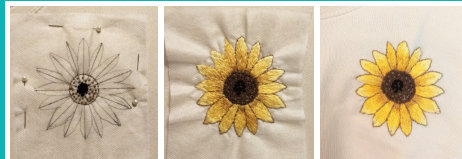
