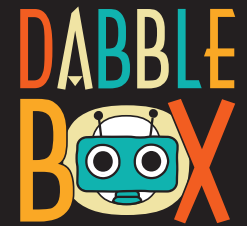


MAKER IN RESIDENCE*

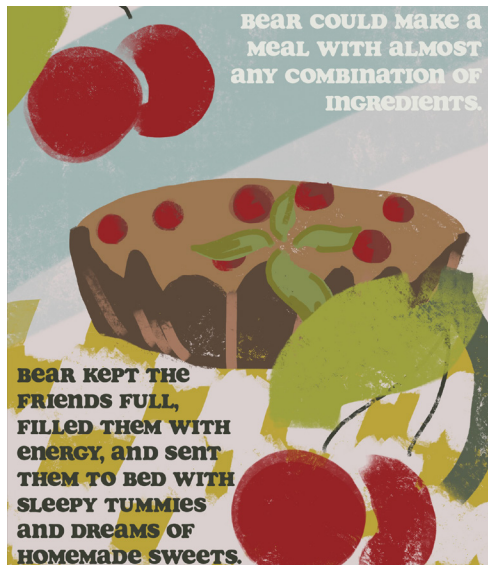

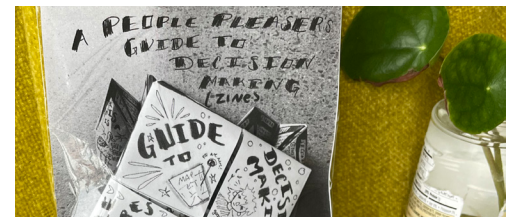

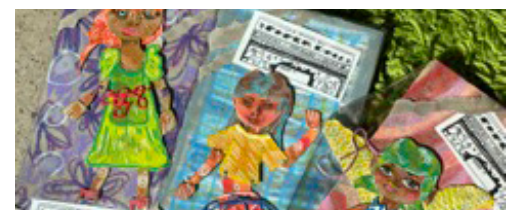
COMICS AND CARTOONING
