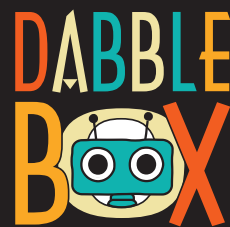


MAKER IN RESIDENCE*

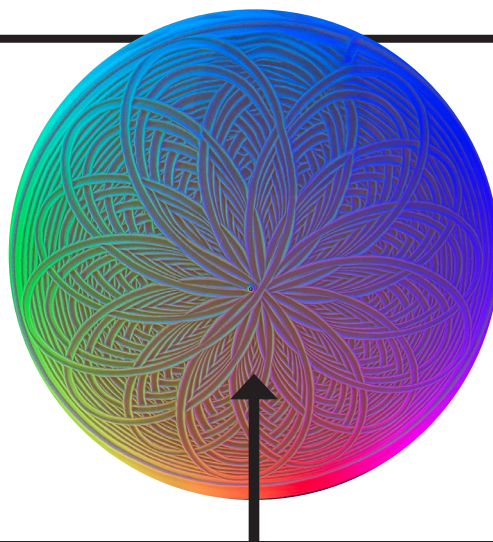

SATURDAY JUNE 7, 10 A.M. TO NOON

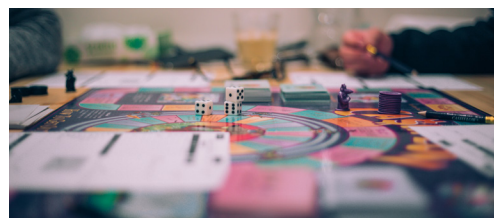
Explore the fundamentals of programming logic, functions, and algorithms with a fun hands-on challenge: writing precise instructions for a "robot" to make a sandwich.
